held for Hent County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County
on the third Tuesday in November instant then and there to give
his evidence on his Lordship's behalf against a certain Richard
Combs Servant to a certain Richard Gresham of the said County Gent
wherewith the same Samuel Hudson acknowledged himself indebted
and now here at this Court to wit at Hent County at the Court house in
the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being
the nineteenth day of said Month anno Domini one thousand seven
hundred and thirty four came the said Samuel Hudson and in his proper
person appeared and prayed that his recognizance might be discharged
ordered by this Court here that the said recognizance be discharged
as prayed
