Be it remembered that on the ninth day of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came Daniel Sarah Manning a Negro Perkin of Kent County in the province of Maryland Plaintiff before me one of the right Honourable the Lord Proprietors his Justices for the said County assigned and acknowledged himself indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietors in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be made and conveyed on his body goods and chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if a certain Lydia Chock shall not make her personal appearance at the next Court to be held for Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November next then and there to give her Evidence on this Lordship's behalf against a certain Sarah Manning a certain Negro belonging to Aquilla Pava Guild called Harbie wherewith the same Daniel Perkin acknowledged himself content

and now here at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in Nov. being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came the said Lydia Chock and in her proper person and appeared and prayed that her sureties recognizance for her appearance may be discharged ordered by this Court that the said recognizance be discharged as prayed Daniel Perkin his recognizance taken as aforesaid for the appearance of the said Lydia Chock is by this Court here discharged
