and County aforesaid planter and there require a true  
list under his hand of all his taxable persons  
Distinctly to be made which he had in his family  
but so to do altogether did neglect against the  
form of the Act of Assembly in such case made &c.  
And that the Sheriff of Kent County have at the  
time & place aforesaid the Said Writ &c.
