 Appointments the said William then and there had
 Notice and the Oath of a Constable of the said Hundred
 then and there did take and the said William was &
 continued Constable of the said Hundred from the said
 third Tuesday in Nov^r until the twenty first day of
 June Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred thirty and three
 to wit at the Hundred of and within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court Nevertheless the said William the duty of his
 Office of Constable regarding on the twentieth day of June
 in the same year or at any time did not repair in
 person to the dwelling house of Thomas Wells of the
