

And the same William Simcocks comes and defends
 the force and Injury when v^o and together that he
 cannot gainsay the Information of so as if a g^o
 him brought he can but say that he is guilty
 of the premises above upon proposed as by the
 Information it is alleged and thereof he submits
 to the Court Therefore it is considered by
 Justice here to wit at the Court at the Court
 house in the town of Chester in said County on the

 of Tobacco according to Act of Assembly in such

 School in said County and it is also considered that
 the same William Simcocks pay the sum
 of two hundred and fifty one pound of Tob^o
 costs accruing on the premises afo to the officers
 of this Court

His Lordship Shew^d W^m being constable
 of usher South Caspar
 William Simcocks Hundred did not take the
 taxables of a certain ^{William}

 thereupon this Court ord^r that his Lordships
 Clerk of Indictments for said Court Exhibit an
