

Wherefore the said attorney prays the advice
of the Court here in the premises for the said
Lord Proprietary and due process of Law against
the said William in this part to sue to answer to
the said Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises

Thereupon Command is given on this five-
teenth day of November in the Twentieth year of our
Lords Dominions Anno Domini One Thousand Seven
Hundred thirty and four to the Sheriff of Kent to
that he shall take William Simcocks of Upper
South Sassafras Hundred in the County of Kent
if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him
safe keep so that he have his body before our Justices
of said County Courts to be held at our Courts house
in the town of Cheston in said County of this third
Tuesday in November Instant to answer unto a
certain Information for not repairing in person to
the Dwelling house of a certain Whilham Church
of the said Hundred and County of Kent and there
require a true list under his hand of all his taxable
person distinctly to be made which he had in his
family but so to do altogether did neglect against
the force of the Act of Assembly in such case made
&c. and that the Sheriff of this County have at
the time and place of the said Writ &c.
Cope Corpus

And now here at the third Tuesday in Nov. came his
said Lordship by Sir Francis his Atty. and
prays that the said William Simcocks to the
Information aforesaid in form aforesaid may answer

And now here the same day and year last
mentioned came the said William Simcocks and
in his proper person appears

And the same William Simcocks comes and
denies the force and injury when &c. and says that
that he cannot gainsay the Information aforesaid
