Shent County ss: Be it remembered that Joseph Francis Gentlly of the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietary that now is wille for the same Lord praying in this part prosecuteth doth come hereinto the County Court of the same Lord Proprietary held for the County and to wit at the Court house at the town of Chester in the County and the Nineteenth day November in the year of our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and four before James Harlip Esq and the rest of his Associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the same Justices here to understand and be informed that a certain Thomas Nason of Lower South Sassafras Hundred in the County of placitor on the third Tuesday of November which was in the year of our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and two and always afterwards untill the day of the Exhibition of this Information being an Inhabitant and Resident within the said Hundred and County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court and as it sheweth to Execute the Office of a Constable in the said Hundred and County and was legally and in due form then and there elected and Appointed to be the Constable of the said Hundred of the said Election and Appointment the same Thomas afterwards to wit the same day and year last mentioned at the place and had Notice and the Oath of a Constable of the Hundred and in due form of Law did take and the same Thomas was and continued Constable of the said Hundred from the third Tuesday of November in the year of our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and two and untill the Twenty first day of June in the year of our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and three to wit at the said Hundred and within the said County & Jurisdiction Nevertheless the same Thomas his Duty of his said office of Constable of the Hundred and in this part Nothing regarding but minding and ~~performing~~ the due Execution of the same office of a Constable and totally to Neglect the Twentieth day of June in the
