proprietor his good Rule and Government and against
the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately
made and provided &c: whereupon the same ~~case~~
~~prosecuting~~ Atty of the said Lord Proprietor for the same
Lord Proprietor mayeth the advice of the Court herein the
premises and that due process of Law in this part may
Issue against the said Thomas to answer unto the same
Lord Proprietor of and Upon the premises &c.

The Warrant Command is given on this thirtieth
day of November in the Twentieth year of our Lord
Dominions Anno Dom One thousand Seven thirty
To the Sheriff of Kent County that he shall
take Thomas as a person of Law in the said Hundred
in the County and planter if he should be found in his
Bailliwick and him safe keep so that he have his body
before our Justices of said County Courts to be held at our
Court house in the town of New York said County of
this third Tuesday of November Instant to answer
unto a certain Information for not repairing in person
to the Dwelling of a certain James Greenwood of the
said Hundred and County planter and there require
a list under his hand of all his taxable persons
distinctly to be made which he had in his family
