

and now here at this Court to wit at the Court house in the Town of  
Master in said County on the third Wednesday in November being the nineteenth day  
of said month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came  
Messrs William Salisbury and in his proper person with that Notwith-  
standing the averment aforesaid he comes and with draws his plea and  
now in his proper person comes and defends the force and injury  
intended and with that he cannot deny the information aforesaid  
nor against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of  
the assault in the information above mentioned and thereupon  
submits to the Court Therefore it is **CONSIDERED** by the Justices  
here to wit the same day and year last mentioned that the same  
William Salisbury be fined the sum of five pounds current money  
of the Province of Maryland to the use of his Lordship his heirs and  
successors as a fine for committing the assault aforesaid in form aforesaid  
and also pay the sum of seven hundred and twenty  
nine pounds of Tobacco tolls accruing on the premises aforesaid to  
the officers of this Court and that the same fees be paid  
by the Master of the said Servants according to the order of aforesaid  
ordered by this Court here that surely be given for the fine aforesaid  
Thereupon Daniel Perkins of Kent County in Court in his  
proper person came and acknowledged himself indebted to the  
right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds  
current money of the Province of Maryland to be made and  
levied on his body goods and chattels lands and tenements  
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors conditionally  
that if the same Daniel Perkins shall not pay unto his said  
Lordship his heirs and successors or their order the above said  
sum of five pounds current money the fine aforesaid against the aforesaid  
William Salisbury whereunto the same Daniel Perkins acknowledges  
himself to be therewith content  
Daniel Perkins at last August Court entered into recognizance for the  
appearance of the aforesaid William Salisbury at this Court and now here  
at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court house in the Town of  
Master in said County on the third Wednesday in November being the  
nineteenth day of said month Anno Domini one thousand seven  
hundred and thirty four came the aforesaid William Salisbury and  
in his proper person appeared and prayed his said Masters recogni-  
zance for his appearance and good behaviour may be discharged  
Ordered by this Court here that the same recognizance be discharged  
as prayed Daniel Perkins aforesaid his recognizance taken as aforesaid in the sum  
of twenty pounds current money for the appearance of the aforesaid
