Whereupon Hugh O'Neil of West County Inholder & Sheriff
herein sent in his proper person but would goth himself indebted
unto the right Honourable the Lord Prop^r in the sum of two
thousand pounds of tobacco to be made & conveyed on his body
goods and Chattels Lands & Tenements to the use of his said
Lordship his heirs and Successors upon condition that if the
said John Pruit do pay the fees and according on the premises
as to the officers of this Court then this recognizance to be
void & to remain in full force in Law

And now here at this Day to wit the sixteenth day of November
in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty three Cometh here
into Court Hugh O'Neil in his proper person and prayeth that
his said recognizance in the sum of two thousand pounds of
Tobacco for the said John Pruit's abiding the Judgment of this
Court may be discharged

Ordered by this Court here that the said Hugh O'Neil his
Recognizance taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

Hugh O'Neil his recognizance taken as aforesaid is by this
Court here discharged their being no cause shown to the
Contrary
