the Jurisdiction of this Court the four and twenty five hundred  
weight of the value of <sup>two</sup> hundred pounds of  
the goods and Chattels aforesaid feloniously did steal take and bear  
away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> his good rule  
and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly  
in such case lately made and provided W. Francis
