Simon Wilmer the fourth day of October anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty six at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court with force & arms a great part of the value of ten hundred pounds of tobacco of the goods & Chattels of Abraham Falconar then and there being found taken & there feloniously did steal take and Bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietor his good rule & government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made & provided by
