

And he who followeth for the Lord Prop^y in like manner saith he is guilty &c

Thereupon Command was given the Sheriff of Stout County that he immediately cause to come hoolob^d by whom & who whether & to recognize &c because as well &c of which said process the said Sheriff to wit William Harris Gent now here at this Day to wit the sixteenth Day of November in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty & six makes return that he hath here ready hoolob^d & as by his process he was Commanded AND now hereafter: -wards to wit the day & year last mentioned come again the said Lord Prop^y by his Attorney and the said John Rowles by his Attorney and the Jurors of that Jury being Impannell'd & called likewise came to wit. Jacob Jones, Christopher Bellian, John M. Dougall, Robert Mootie, Philip Ricketts, George Griffith, James Ringgold (Langford's Bay) Peter Jones George Medford, Benjamin Green, James Ringgold (Forest), Thomas Manham, who being duly Oath'd try'd & sworn to say the truth in the promises and the said Lord Prop^y by his Attorney appearing to the Verdict of the Jurors and upon their Oath do say that the said John Rowles is not guilty as he stande Judic'd and by Jacob Jones there foreman they all so say &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here to wit at Stout County and at the Courthouse in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of Nov. being the sixteenth Day of said month in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty & six that the said John Rowles as to the Judgment and he be therefrom Acquitted and that all proceedings thereunto relating cease

Also it is Considered by the Justice and at the time and place and that the said John pay the sum of six hundred and eighty four pounds of tobacco costs accruing on the promises and to the several officers of the Court
