It is Remembered that on the fourth day of September in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty three Came before me the Subscriber One of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County of Northampton and Acknowledged himself indebted unto the right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five pounds current money of Maryland to be made & Satisfied on his body goods & Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors upon Condition that he do make his Appearance at the next Court to be held for the County of Northampton as an Evidence in behalf of his Lordships against Major Sam<sup>l</sup> Thomas Then this writ to be void Else to remain in full force in Law
