Ordered by this Court here that the afo Mary give Security for
the Goods arising on the promises afo to the several Officers
of this Court

Thereupon Francis Jones of West County Gent^l present
here in Court in his proper person acknowledged himself
Indebted unto the right honourable the Lord Prop^r in the sum
of five hundred pounds of tobacco to be made and Seized on
his body goods and Chattels Land and Tenements to the use of
the said Lordship his heirs and Successors upon condition
that the afo Mary Burn do pay the Goods arising on the
promises afo to the several Officers of this Court. Then
this recognizance to be void tho to remain in full force in
