 indebted unto the right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in the sum  
 of forty pounds current money of Maryland Cash to be made  
 and levied on their body goods and Chattels Lands Tenements  
 to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors upon  
 condition that the said Daniel Flinn do make his personal  
 appearance before the Justice of our next County Court to be  
 held for the County of Daniel on the third Tuesday of November next to  
 answer unto what shall be required against him on his Lordship's  
 behalf and to do or suffer therein. Then this recognizance to be  
 void else to remain in full force in Law

It is remembered that on the eighth day of Dec<sup>r</sup>  
 in the year of our Lord 1736 on the second hundred thirty six<sup>th</sup> (and before  
 me the Subscriber One of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the  
 County of Peter Alford and Richard Miles of the County of Labour  
 and acknowledged themselves indebted unto the right Honourable  
 the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five pounds current money of Cash  
 to be made and levied on their body goods and Chattels Lands  
 and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and  
 Successors upon condition that the said Peter & Richard do  
 make their personal appearance before the Justice of our  
 next County Court to be held for the County of Daniel and there to do  
 or suffer in behalf of his Lordship's body goods and Chattels  
 the said Daniel. Then this recognizance to be void else to remain  
 in full force in Law

It is remembered by the Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord  
 Proprietor that now is for the body of the County of Daniel upon these  
 Oaths do present that Daniel Flinn of the Parish of St. Pauls in the  
 County of Labour on the twelfth day of August Anno Domini
