As Sarah to the Indutment as might answer  
At which said day cometh her into Court the said Sarah and saith  
that she cannot gainway the Indutment as do as against her  
brought nor can she say but that she is guilty of the premises as  
above upon her imposed as by the Indutment as it is alledged and  
thereupon she submit to the Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at West  
County as at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the  
third Tuesday of November being the twentieth day of said month  
in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty six that the said  
Sarah have on her bear back fifteen shillings wole laid on toll the  
Blood appear — Also it is considered by the Justices as  
at the time and place as that the said Sarah pay the sum of  
two hundred and forty six pounds of lawful money accruing  
on the premises as to the several officers of this Court

It is also considered on the day and year as that William  
Starris Gent Sheriff of West County take the body of the said Sarah  
into his custody and Execute the punishment in the Judgment  
as specified and afterwards to bring her into Court again of  
which said precept to wit William Starris Gent of the said County  
makes return thereon the day and year last mentioned that  
he hath Executed the punishment in the Judgment as specified  
as by the said precept he was Command and also hath her the said  
Sarah here before the Court

body
