Comin and did Alld now here after wards to wit the day and year last mentioned Comin again the s<sup>d</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> & Mary Obyant by their Attor<sup>n</sup> and the Jurors of that Jury being Impannelled & called & the witnesses to wit Samuel Jovey, William Bradshaw, William Moor, J<sup>n</sup>: Brwick, Jeromiah Covington, Rob<sup>t</sup>: Yusby, Francis Reed, Michael Stubbart, Henry Tuleck, George Griffiths, Francis Bellows, George Garnett who being duly asked tried & sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Obyant is not guilty as by the Information a<sup>d</sup> it is alleged on by Samuel Jovey, their Foreman all & sayth

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at Kent County a<sup>d</sup>: at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March being the day and year a<sup>d</sup> last mentioned that the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Obyant as to the s<sup>d</sup> Information a<sup>d</sup> she be thereupon acquitted, and that all proceedings thereunto relating cease &

Also it is considered that the s<sup>d</sup> Mary pay the sum of One thousand pounds of tobacco due according on the premises a<sup>d</sup> to the several officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court here that the s<sup>d</sup> Mary Obyant give Security for a<sup>d</sup>: according on the premises a<sup>d</sup> to the several officers of this Court

Thereupon Hugh O'Neil of Chester Town Gentleman & of record in this Court acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Right Honourable the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> in the full sum of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco to be made and conveyed in his body goods and chattels Land and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors upon condition that if the s<sup>d</sup> Mary do & shall well & truly pay unto the s<sup>d</sup> Officers according on the premises a<sup>d</sup> to the several officers of this Court, that she above Recognizance to be void she to remain in full peace & quiet in said

Alld now here to wit the fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord seven hundred thirty & six cometh here unto Court the s<sup>d</sup> Mary and prayeth that her surety Recognizance taken in the sum of twenty pounds current money of Maryland Cash maybe discharged

Ordered by this Court here that John Canady his Recognizance
