Thatharine Kelly Kent County for selling Vignor Contrary to Law

Ordered by this Court here that John Smith and Anne Harrison enter into Recognizance for their appearance at next June Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester on the third Tuesday of June month as Evidence against the afo Thatharine in behalf of His Lordship.

Thereupon John Smith comes here into Court and Acknowledges himself Indebted unto the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor the sum of five pounds current money of Maryland to be made and Swept on your body goods and chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors With Condition that if he the said John Smith do make his personal appearance before the Justices of our next County Court to be held as afo to testify as an Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the Thatharine Then this Recognizance to be void else to remain in full force & Virtue in Law.

Also Anne Harrison comes here into Kent County Court as in his proper person and Acknowledges himself Indebted unto the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five pounds current money of Maryland to be made and Swept on your body goods & chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors With Condition that if he the said Anne Harrison do make his personal appearance before the Justices of our next County Court to be held as afo then and there to testify as an Evidence in behalf of His Lordship against the afo Thatharine Then this Recognizance to be void else to remain in full force & Virtue in Law.

It is ordered by this Court here that the Clerk of Indictments Glibell an Information against the afo Thatharine.
