said County then and there to be satisfied in behalf of his Lordship against
the said Edward M^cCaum. Then this Recognizance to be Void -
Else to remain in full force and Virtue in Law

The said William Mafy being sworn to the grand Jury after
which they return the following Indictment

Kent County J^t. The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord
Proprietary that now is for the body of Kent County and upon their Oath
do present that Edward M^cCaum Jun^r. late of Shrewsbury -
Parish in the County of Lancaster the tenth day of November Anno
Domini Seventeen hundred thirty six at the Parish aforesaid in the
County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court with force
and Arms & One Boe live of the Value of twelve pounds of
tobacco and two pounds of loose therein being of the Value of twenty
pounds of tobacco and One gallon of honey in the same live then
likewise being of the Value of forty pounds of tobacco of the goods
and Chattle of a certain Henry Spencer then and there being found
then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary
to the Peace of the said Lord Proprietary his good rule and
Government and Against the form of the Act of Assembly in
such case lately made and Provided &c
