Court to answer unto a certain Indictment of Felony & Alled that
the Sheriff of Kent County have here before the Court the said Writ
At which said fifteenth day of March in the year aforesaid
William Harris Gentleman Sheriff of Kent County & made return
thereof to the Court here. Endowed as fold Viz.

The said Henry appearing to the Writ. the Court Order
that the said Henry enter into Recognizance in the sum of
fifty pounds for his appearance to the next Court to be
held for the County aforesaid with good Security &c.

Thereupon Henry Spencer Joseph Gleaves and Nicholas
Vansant of Kent County Planters and present here in Court in
their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto
the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary (that is to say Henry
Spencer in the sum of fifty pounds current money of Maryland
Joseph Gleaves and Nicholas Vansant in the sum of twenty five
pounds like money Each, to be made & payed on your body
goods and Chattle and Inmovable to the use of His said Lordship
his heirs and Successors With condition that if the said
Henry do make his personal appearance before Justice of
our next County Court to be held for the County aforesaid on the third Tuesday
of June next then and there to answer unto such things as shall
be objected against him on behalf of his Lordship. Then
this Recognizance to be void & he to remain in full force in Law
