June being the twenty first day of said month in the year of our Lord
Seventeen hundred thirty seven cometh the said ~~James~~ ^{James} by ~~James~~ ^{James}
Francis his Attorney and Prayeth that the said Coan to the Justice
do might answer &c

And the said Coan James in his proper Person comes and defends
the force and injury when & and with that he cannot gain any
the Judgment as do as against him brought nor convey
but that he is guilty of Promises as against him Imposed as
by the said Information it is alleged and thereupon Submits
to the Court &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at that
Court as at the Court holden in the Town of Chester in said County
on the third Tuesday of June being the day & year as last mentioned
that the said Coan do find according to Act of Assembly in that
case made and provided &c for committing the said Offence
Also it is considered on the day & year as that the said Coan
pay the sum of three hundred and forty five Pounds of Tobacco
due according on the premises as to the several Officers
of this Court &c

Ordered by this Court here that the said Coan James give Security
for the fine as as mentioned

Thereupon Coan James & Benjamin Blackstone
do present here in Court in their proper Persons acknowledge
themselves indebted unto the said ~~James~~ ^{James} in the sum of five
Pounds each to be made and payed on their bodies goods &
Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of this said Court
his heirs and Successors With Condition that if the said Coan
do pay the fine as according to Act of Assembly &c then their
Recognizance to be void Else to remain in full force and Virtue
in Law

Ordered by this Court here that the said Coan give Security
for the fine as according on the premises as to the several
Officers of this Court
