Thereupon Doctor Alex^r Adair & Calab Butch of Kent County & present herein Court Acknowledged themselves Debted unto the Lord Prop^r of this Province in the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco Cash to be made & conveyed on their bodies goods & Chattels Vinds & Invements to the use of his said Vindship his heirs & Successors With Condition that if the said Samuel Barton do pay the fine as according on the premises as to the Officers of this Court. Then this Recogniz^{ance} to be void else to remain in full force in Law

This Writ of Command was given the Sheriff of Kent County on the twenty first day of June in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred thirty seven that he should take Samuel Barton late of Saint Pauls Parish in the County of Carpenter & he should be found in his Bailwick and him as to keep so that he have his body before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Charles in said County on the third Tuesday of June being the twenty first day of said month to answer unto a certain presentment for assaulting William Aboley. And that the said Sheriff had at the time and place as the said Writ
