Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Susanna prove the father of the said Thereupon the aforesaid Susanna proved that John Egan was the father of the aforesaid Child and Ordered by the Court here that an Information be exhibited against the aforesaid John for the sum aforesaid.

Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Susanna give Security for the aforesaid sum owing on the promises aforesaid to the Officers of this Court and she having no One to offer nor no One offering for her Thereupon she is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Westmorland until the aforesaid sum owing on the promises aforesaid to the Officers of this Court be satisfied.

Ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Susanna give Security for to keep the County herimself from the Maintenance of the aforesaid Child.

Thereupon Nicholas Mayley Acknowledges himself Indebted unto the right honourable the Lord Proprietary the sum of two thousand pounds of tobacco to be made and Levyed on his body good and chattel Land and Tenements to the two of the said Lordships his heirs beforo conditionally that if the aforesaid Child do not come upon the County then this Recognizance to be void like to remain in full force & Virtue in Law where with the said Nicholas Acknowledges himself to be content.
