Tenement to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors
Conditionally that of the afo Robert do not make his personal
Appearance at the next August Court to be held for the County afo
at the Court house in the Town of Annapolis as Procurator against
the afo Thomas Richards Then this Recognaunce to be Owe
Elio to remain in full fonde and Virtue in Law

Ordered by this Court here that Alice Morton widow into recogniz
for her Appearance at the next August Court to Testifie as an
Evidence against the afo Thomas Richards

Whereupon John Morton Acknowledges him selfe debted
unto the right honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of
Pounds current money of Maryland to be made and Voyed
on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenement to the use
of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that
if the afo Elio do not make her personal at the next August
Court to be held for the County afo to Testifie as an
Evidence against the afo Thomas Richards in behalf of the
Lordship Then this Recognaunce to be Owe Elio to remain
in full fonde and Virtue in Law
