Therefore Robert Jackson of Kent County Gentleman and Justice here in Court Acknowledgeth himself indebted unto the right honorable the Lord Prop^r in the sum of five pounds current money of Maryland to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Robert do not make his personal Appearance at the next August Court to be hold for the County and at the Court house in the Town of Annapolis as prosecutor against the said Thomas Richards Then this Recognizance to be void Else to remain in full force and Virtue in Law

Ordered by this Court here that Alice Morton enter into Recognizance for her Appearance at the next August Court to Testify as an Evidence against the said Thomas Richards

Therefore John Morton Acknowledgeth himself indebted unto the right honorable the Lord Prop^r in the sum of five pounds current money of Maryland to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Alice do not make her personal Appearance at the next August Court to be hold for the County and to Testify as an Evidence against the said Thomas Richards in behalf of the Lordship Then this Recognizance to be void Else to remain in full force and Virtue in Law
