Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty six that the said  
Robert be fine the sum of thirty Shillings current money for committing  
the said Fornication — Also it is considered by the Justices as  
on the Day & Year as that the said Robert pay the sum of One hundred &  
twenty One pounds of Tobacco to be assessed on the Premises as to the  
officer of this Court —

Ordered by this Court here that the said Robert Deliver the fine as to the  
Sherrif of Kent County and William Harris Esq<sup>r</sup> <sup>Sherrif</sup> present here in Court  
Acknowledge the receipt of the same —

Ordered by the Court here that the said Robert give Security for to keep the  
County harmless from the said Child —

Thereupon Joseph Nicholson of Kent County Gentleman present  
herein Court Acknowledge <sup>himself</sup> indebted into the Right Honourable the Lord  
Prop<sup>r</sup> in the sum of five thousand of Tobacco to be made and levied  
on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said  
Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the said Bastard  
Child should <sup>not</sup> come upon the County Then the above recognizance to be void  
Else to remain in full force and Virtue in Law —

His Lordship — Kent County s<sup>h</sup>. Be it remembered that  
Rachel Bostick on the twenty ninth Day of November in the  
Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred &  
thirty six came before me the Subscriber One of his Lordships Justices  
of the Peace for the County as Rachel Bostick and Acknowledge herself  
indebted into the Right Honourable the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> in the sum of twenty  
pounds current money of Maryland to be made and levied on her body  
goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lordship  
his heirs and Successors conditionally that if she do not make her  
Personal appearance at the next March Court to be held for the  
County as to answer unto a presentment found against her by the grand  
Jury
