Return the following Indictment

Went County s^r. The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord
Proprietor that now is for the body of the County aforesaid upon their Oath
do affirm that Samuel Humphreys late of Saint Pauls Parish in
the County aforesaid planter the tenth Day of March Anno Domini Seventeen
hundred thirty and five at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid & within
the Jurisdiction of this Court horses of Bay colour of the price of five
pounds current money each of the goods and Chattels of William Taylor
then and there being found then and there with force and Arms to
wit with Sticks Staves and Clubs did chase drive and wound and
Beat whereby the same horse were hurt and Damified to their
harm to the said William Taylor then and there did to the great
Damage of the said William and against the peace of the said
Lord Proprietor his good rule and Government &c. — **Præsumit**

On the Back of the aforesaid Indictment was this Entered
Ignoramus by Tho. Hatcheron Foreman

Ordered by this Court here that the said Samuel give Security for
the Peace according on the premises aforesaid to the several officers of
this Court and he having no One to offer nor no One offering for
him Thereupon he is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff
of the County until the Peace according on the premises aforesaid be
Satisfied as aforesaid

And now here at this Day to wit the fifteenth Day of June
in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty & six Cometh
here into Court the said Samuel in his proper person and prays that
that his and his Jurors recognizance taken in the sum of five
pounds current money of Maryland for his Appearance
to
