The then common & usual rate & price of such Liquor there between Merchants and others to wit for the sum of four pounds current money of Maryland to be drawn in the dwelling house of the said Lidia Chick of the parish of in the County of and within the said Jurisdiction being and about the plantation of her the said Lidia Chick to the said House belonging & Appertaining without any Lawfull Licence or Authority so to do contrary to the act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided &c. Wherefore the said Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth the Advice of the Court herein the Case and that due proofs of Law in this part against the said Lidia Chick may be made to answer unto the said Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.

And now here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March being the eighteenth day of said month in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty six by his Attorney of and prayeth that the said Lidia to the action aforesaid might answer.

All which said third Tuesday of March cometh the said Lidia in her proper and prayeth that the action aforesaid may be continued until the third Tuesday of June of which was granted.

All which said third Tuesday of June being the fifteenth day of said month in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred thirty six the said Lidia and saith she is not guilty of the premises above upon her Impeachment & thereupon by the Information aforesaid it is alledged and for tryal she puts herself upon the Country.

And he who followeth for the Lord Proprietary in like manner says she is guilty.

Ordered by the Court here that the said Lidia give Security for her appearance during Court sitting.

Thereupon Sutor M. of the County planter and Justice herein Court acknowledged himself Indebted unto the right honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland to be made & conveyed on his body goods & Chattels Lands and to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Assigns &c. and so the said Sutor conditionally that if she shall not make her personal appearance

and
