

June Court 1736

Ordered by the Court here that the said Samuel give Security for the Fees and Arruening on the Promises as to the officers of this Court and he having no One to offer nor to One offering for him Thereupon he is committed into the Custody of the Sher of Kent County until the Fees and Arruening on the Promises as to the several officers of this Court be Satisfied

The Lordship of Candemund was given the Sher of Kent County on the twenty eighth Day of November in the fourth first year of King George the Third in the Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty five that he should take Elizabeth Young the wife of John Young late of Kent County Taylor if she should be found in his Bailwick and her safe keep so that you have her body before the Justice of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Rochester in said County on the third Tuesday of March next to answer unto a Proventus found against her for committing adultery with a certain Capt. John Dunbar and that the said Sher have at the time and place as the said Proventus

And now here at this Day to wit the Sixteenth Day of March in the Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred & thirty five Cometh William Harris Gent. Sheriff of the said County and made return thereof to the Court here Endowed as follows Viz. *Levi corpora* W. W. Harris Sher

Kent County &c. Be it Reminded that Sir Francis Gant Attorney of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietors who for the Saids Lord Proprietors had for the County as in this Part Prossueth doth come here into the County Court of the Saids Lord Proprietors
