Thereupon Bowler Green and Henry Green of Kent County Planters and present herein Court Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto the right honourable the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five thousand pounds of Tobacco Each to be made and Seized on their Body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and assigns conditionally that if the said Mary Gent do not keep the County harmless from the said Lordship Then the above Proclamations to be void and to remain in full force and Virtue
