And now here at this Day to wit the seventeenth Day of August in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty & six the said Lord prays the said Lord prays by Joseph Francis his Attorney and prays that the said Samuel to the Inform^r as might answer

At which said third Tuesday of August being the Day of Year as aforesaid he came into Court the said Samuel Thomas in his proper person and saith that he cannot deny the Information as so as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises above upon him Imp^d and thereupon he the said Samuel submits to the Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justice how to wit at North County as at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of August being the seventeenth Day of said month in the year as that the said Samuel Thomas pay the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco as a fine for not clearing the Roads as aforesaid according to Act of Assembly

Also it is considered by the Justice as at the same place that the said Samuel pay that sum of two hundred eighty & four pounds of tobacco as a fine upon the premises as to the several officers of the Court
