 Six that the said Rhoda Davie pay the sum of One pound Ten  
 Shillings current money as a fine for committing the said offence  
 And it is Considered by the Justice and at the time and place and  
 that the said Rhoda Davie pay the sum of three hundred fifty and  
 Eight pounds of tobacco to be current on the promise and to  
 the officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court here that the fine and be received the Clerk  
 of the County. And William Staines your Clerk of the said County  
 and present heron Court in his proper person Acknowledge the  
 Receipt of the same

Ordered by this Court here that the said Rhoda Davie give  
 Security for the Good and Current on the promise and to the  
 Several officers of this Court

Thereupon Edward Beck and Benjamin Beard of the County  
 Planters and present heron Court in their proper person  
 Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto the right honourable the  
 Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> in the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco Cash  
 to be made and Secured on their body goods Chattels Lands &  
 Tenements to the use of the said Lordship his heirs and Successors  
 Conditionally that if the said Rhoda pay the Good and to the  
 Several officers of this Court Then the above recognizance to  
 the Lord be to remain in full force in Law
