Ordered by this Court that the said Rhoda give Security for to keep the County harmless from the Child -  
Thereupon Edward Beck and Benjamin Ruard both of West County planters and present heron Court in their proper person acknowledged themselves indebted unto the Right Honourable the Lord Prop. in the sum of five thousand pounds of tobacco to be made and secured on their bodies good will Chastity and Innocence to the use of the said Lordships his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the said Rhoda Davise Child do not come upon the County then the said recognizance to be void Else to remain in full force in Law

His Lordship's Comizance was given the third of June in the County second year of our Dominion in the year of our

Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty that he should take Elinor Proffe late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Spinkler of the hall he found in his Parish and her self heep do that you have her Body before the Justice of our next County Court to hold a Court Court house in the Town of Chester in the County on the third Tuesday of August next to answer unto a certain Judgment for the sum of four hundred and fifty pounds and that the said Elinor have at the time and place and the said writ

At which said third Tuesday of August being the Seventeenth Day of said month in the year of our Lord William Harris Sheriff of West County and made return thereof to the Court here shown as follows vizt - Elinor Proffe W. Harris Sheriff of West County for the Justice for the Right Honourable the Lord Prop. that now is for the body of West County and upon their Oath do present that Elinor Proffe late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Spinkler the tenth Day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty and five at the parish of in the County of and within the jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a
