And now heard at this Day to wit the Twentieth day of August
 in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty six Cometh
 the said Lordship by his Attorney at Law and prayeth that the said
 Elinor to the Indictment aforesaid might Answer

At which said third Monday of August being the day & year aforesaid
 Cometh the said Elinor her own Court in her proper person and
 saith that she cannot gain say the Indictment aforesaid as against
 her brought on her the day but that she is guilty of the premises
 aforesaid upon her Imposed as by the Indictment aforesaid is alleged
 & thereupon she submits to the Court

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices hereto writ at Shrewsbury

 Shillings well laid on until the blood appear
