

Lord Prop^r in the sum of twenty pounds current money of Maryland to be made & levied on his body goods and Chattels Land and Tenements to the use of the said Lord & his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the said Richard Pope do make his personal appearance at the next August Court to be hold for the County aforesaid and in the mean time to keep the peace & be of good behaviour Then this recognizance to be void Else to remain in full force in Law

Thout County sh^r. The Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord Proprietarie that now is for the City of Thout County aforesaid upon their Oath do present that Richard Pope late of Thout Pauls Parish in the County aforesaid Labourer the first Day of August Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty six at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Harry the Negro Slave of Joseph Young Esq^r in the Parish of St Paul of the said Lord Prop^r then and there being with force and Arms and Shauls did make and the said Harry then & there did beat wound and Evilly Treat so that of his life it was greatly Disparde and other harme to him then & there did to the great Damage of the said Harry and against the peace of the said Lord Prop^r by his good rule & Government

AND now hold at this Day to wit the seventh day of August in the Year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty six and six Cometh the aforesaid Lord Proprietarie by Francis Francis his Attorney and prayeth that the said Richard to the Inditment aforesaid might answer

At which said third day of August being the day and Year aforesaid Cometh herunto Court the said Richard Pope in his proper person and saith that he cannot gain say the Inditment aforesaid so as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the promises aforesaid above upon him
