if he should be found in your Bailiwick and him self together that you  
lead his body before the Justice of our next County Court to be held  
Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday  
of November next to answer unto a certain Indenture and Judgment  
for committing fornication with a certain Mary Thomack  
And that the Sheriff of said County lead at the time of said Indenture  
said Indenture

At which said third Tuesday of November being the last day  
of said month in the year of our Lord 1736 the said Indenture  
came William Harris Sheriff of the County of Chester and  
to the front hereof Endowed as follows  
That was to wit the body of West Cheshire upon these Conditions  
That Archdeacon Crown late of St Pauls Parish in the County of Chester  
the tenth Day of June in the year of our Lord 1736  
hundred and thirty five at the parish of St Mary in the County of Chester  
the Jurisdiction of the Court did commit fornication with a certain  
Mary Thomack and of her body then and there had carnal knowledge  
and a Bastard child on the body of her said Mary Thomack then  
Did begett to the high displeasure of our said Majesty the King  
Examples of all others in such case offending by the Statute  
of the said King George the Third that now is his good pleasure  
and against the form of the Act of Parliament in such behalf  
made and provided
