

CHAPTER 127

(Senate Bill 344)

AN ACT concerning

Wildlife - Nongame and Endangered Species
Conservation Act

FOR the purpose of conserving endangered and threatened species of wildlife and plants by authorizing the Secretary of Natural Resources to conduct investigations on nongame species; issue rules and regulations and to develop conservation programs; establish an endangered and threatened species list, prohibit the taking of threatened and endangered species with certain exceptions; enabling the Secretary to consult with other states, Federal agencies and other interested persons and organizations, clarifying terms by use of definition, providing penalties for violations of search and seizure of articles used in violation of this Act; and relating generally to endangered and threatened wildlife and plants.
