- UPON RECEIPT OF THE REQUIRED FEE, (F) DEPARTMENT OR THE COURT CLERK SHALL GIVE THE APPLICANT A DUPLICATE COPY OF THE APPLICATION, WHICH SERVES AS A TEMPORARY LICENSE FOR 15 DAYS TO PACK OR SHIP CRABS. AFTER ISSUING THE TEMPORARY LICENSE, THE COURT CLERK SHALL FORWARD, WITHIN 48 HOURS, THE ORIGINAL COPY OF THE APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT, FIRST-CLASS MAIL, SHALL SEND THE LICENSE TO APPLICANT. THE COURT CLERK SHALL FORWARD MONTHLY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE FEES RECEIVED FROM APPLICANTS FOR DEPOSIT TO THE CREDIT OF THE FISHERIES RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT FUND.
- (G) EVERY CRAB PACKER'S OR SHIPPER'S LICENSE IS VALID FOR THE YEAR IT IS ISSUED.
- (H) A PERSON LICENSED TO SHIP OR PACK CRABS IS NOT REQUIRED TO PROCURE ANY FURTHER LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect [[July 1, 1975]] January 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 183

(House Bill 110)

AN ACT concerning

Fish and Fisheries - Commercial Crabber's License

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department to accept applications for commercial crabber's licenses; clarifying the fees to be paid at the time of application for the license; and requiring applicants to certify that the facts set forth in the application are true.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
