sufficient grounds to deny an application.

CHAPTER 187

(House Bill 123)

AN ACT concerning

Oysters - Dredging License

FOR the purpose of eliminating the requirement that the seller and purchaser of a licensed dredge boat must personally appear before the Department of Natural Resources and make oath to every fact contained in the application to transfer a dredge boat license; requiring the seller and purchaser of a licensed dredge boat to certify on the application to transfer the dredge boat license that the statements made by him in the application are true; and requiring a transfer fee.
