(a) Each license [issued under this subtitle] shall state the address at which the licensed business is to be conducted and shall state fully the name of the licensee [and, if the licensee is a copartnership or association, the names of the members thereof, and if a corporation, the date and place of its incorporation and the address of its principal place of business. Such]. THE license shall be kept conspicuously posted in the licensee's specified place of business and [shall not be transferable or assignable.] MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR ASSIGNED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

(House Bill 130)
