Public Local Laws of Charles County being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1969 Edition and 1972 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed.

(House Bill 1160)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - County Treasurer

FOR the purpose of changing the date for the beginning of the term of the Charles County Treasurer.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Charles County Section 79 Article 9 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1969 Edition and 1972 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 79 of the Public Local Laws of Charles County being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1969 Edition and 1972 Supplement), be and it is hereby repealed and re—enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 9

79.

At the general election on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1950, and every four years thereafter, a County Treasurer shall be elected by the qualified voters of Charles County[, who shall hold office for the term of four years from the fifteenth day of May next following his election and until his successor shall qualify, who shall be eligible for re-election]. THE TERM OF THE TREASURER IS FOUR YEARS AND BEGINS ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN DECEMBER FOLLOWING THE
