not be applicable to Class B beer, wine and liquor licenses regulated by the provisions of § 106 of this article. Where the provisions of this section are in conflict with §§ 89 and 99 of this article for Harford County §§ 89 and 99 shall govern. For Somerset County the provisions of this section shall be subordinate to § 104A of this subtitle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
