STATE AND PARTLY IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION, OR WHICH IS CONDUCTED OR COMMITTED IN MORE THAN ONE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.

- (E) HE SHALL, AT THE REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR OR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND HE MAY, AT THE REQUEST OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, A STATE PROSECUTOR, OR A CIRCUIT ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE, INVESTIGATE OR ASSIST A STATE PROSECUTOR IN THE INVESTIGATION OF ANY CRIMINAL OFFENSE; AND HE MAY PROSECUTE OF ASSIST A STATE PROSECUTOR IN THE PROSECUTION OF SUCH OFFENSE.
- (1) HE SHALL, BEGINNING WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 1978, PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, AFTER REVIEW AND COMMENT BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, A CONSOLIDATED BUDGET FOR HIS OFFICE, INCLUDING THE SALARY OF THE SEVERAL STATE PROSECUTORS, IN ACCOPDANCE WITH LAW AND THE NORMAL BUDGET PROCEDURES. HE SHALL, BEGINNING WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 1979, PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, AFTER REVIEW AND COMMENT BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, A CONSOLIDATED BUDGET FOR HIS OFFICE AND COMPENSATION OF THE SEVERAL STATE PROSECUTORS PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE SEVERAL STATE PROSECUTORS* OFFICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW AND THE NORMAL BUDGET PROCEDURES. HE SHALL, IN THE PREPARATION OF THE BUDGET, CONSULT WITH THE STATE PROSECUTORS. THE COUNTIES AND THE CITY OF BALTIMORE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE AND PAY COSTS RELATING TO THE STATE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE EXCEPT AS SET OUT IN THIS SECTION (F) (1), INCLUDING NECESSARY OFFICE SPACE.
- (2) HE SHALL ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT UNIFORM REPORTING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE STATE PROSECUTORS. HE MAY REQUIRE PERIODIC REPORTS CONCERNING THEIR BUDGETS AND OPERATIONS AND MAY AUDIT THESE REPORTS.
- (3) HE MAY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RELIEVING AN ACCUMULATION OF BUSINESS IN THE OFFICE OF A STATE PROSECUTOR OR IN HIS OFFICE, OR OTHERWISE UPON THE REQUEST OF A STATE PROSECUTOR, ASSIGN ANY STATE PROSECUTOR, DEPUTY, OR ASSISTANT TO WORK TEMPORARILY WITH ANOTHER STATE PROSECUTOR, OR IN HIS OFFICE. HE SHALL NOT ASSIGN A STATE PROSECUTOR WITHOUT HIS CONSENT.
- (4) HE SHALL ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT STANDARD AND SPECIALIZED TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR STATE PROSECUTORS AND THEIR PROFESSIONAL STAFF, AND HE MAY REQUIRE THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THESE PROGRAMS.
- (G) TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, HE SHALL DEVELOP AND PROVIDE SUPPORT AND INNFORMATIONAL SERVICES TO THE STATE PROSECUTORS, INCLUDING TECHNICAL AND PROFESSIONAL PUBLICATIONS, AND ADVICE, INFORMATION AND ASSISTANCE WITH RESPECT TO THE EFFECTIVE AND
