SUBTITLE 2. FEES AND RECORDING.

1-201. RECORDING OR FILING OF CHARTER AND OTHER DOCUMENTS.

(A) DOCUMENT FAILING TO CONFORM WITH LAW NOT TO BE RECORDED.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ACCEPT FOR RECORD ANY CHARTER DOCUMENT OF A MARYLAND CORPORATION WHICH DOES NOT CONFORM WITH LAW. HOWEVER, ANY DOCUMENT WHICH PURPORTS TO BE ACKNOWLEDGED MAY BE TREATED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS PROPERLY ACKNOWLEDGED.

(B) PAYMENT OF FILING FEES, SPECIAL FEES, AND BONUS TAX.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ACCEPT FOR RECORD OR FILING ANY CHARTER DOCUMENT, QUALIFICATION, REGISTRATION, CHANGE OF RESIDENT AGENT OR PRINCIPAL OFFICE, REPORT, SERVICE OF PROCESS OR NOTICE, OR OTHER DOCUMENT UNTIL ALL REQUIRED RECORDING, FILING, AND OTHER SPECIAL FEES AND ANY BONUS TAX HAVE BEEN PAID TO THE DEPARTMENT.

1-202. RECORDATION OF CHARTER DOCUMENT.

(A) DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT ACCEPTS FOR RECORD ANY CHARTER DOCUMENT OR ANY DOCUMENT DESIGNATING OR CHANGING THE NAME OR ADDRESS OF A RESIDENT AGENT OR PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF A MARYLAND CORPORATION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) INDORSE ON THE DOCUMENT THE DATE AND TIME OF ITS ACCEPTANCE FOR RECORD;

(2) RECORD PROMPTLY THE DOCUMENT WITH ITS CORPORATE RECORDS;
