6-409. CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE.

(A) EXAMINATION BY COMMISSIONER.

BEFORE THE COMMISSIONER ISSUES A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE, HE MAY MAKE ANY EXAMINATION AND REQUIRE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION HE CONSIDERS NECESSARY.

(B) ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE.

ON PRESENTATION OF SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT THE SOCIETY HAS COMPLIED WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE TO THE SOCIETY A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WHICH AUTHORIZES THE SOCIETY TO TRANSACT BUSINESS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) CERTIFICATE AS EVIDENCE.

THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF THE EXISTENCE OF THE SOCIETY AS OF THE DATE OF THE CERTIFICATE.

(D) RECORD OF CERTIFICATE.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL RECORD IN HIS OFFICE THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE.

The provision of present §314 which relates to the evidentiary value of a certified copy is deleted as unnecessary in light of §10-204 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article.
