

ENGAGED IN ONE OR MORE CRAFTS OR HAZARDOUS OCCUPATIONS IN THE SAME OR SIMILAR LINES OF BUSINESS; AND

(II) INSURES ONLY ITS MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES AND DEPENDENTS;

(3) SOCIETY OR AUXILIARY OF AN ORDER, SOCIETY, OR ASSOCIATION DESCRIBED IN ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

(4) DOMESTIC SOCIETY WHICH:

(I) LIMITS ITS MEMBERSHIP TO EMPLOYEES OF A PARTICULAR MUNICIPAL AREA OR A DESIGNATED FIRM, BUSINESS HOUSE, OR CORPORATION;

(II) PROVIDES FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL DEATH BENEFITS NOT EXCEEDING \$400 PER YEAR AND DISABILITY BENEFITS NOT EXCEEDING \$350 PER YEAR; AND

(III) DOES NOT ISSUE BENEFIT CERTIFICATES;
AND

[[(IV) DOES NOT HAVE A MEMBERSHIP OF MORE THAN 1,000 INDIVIDUALS; AND]]

(5) DOMESTIC SOCIETY OR ASSOCIATION WHICH:

(I) HAS A PURELY RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE, OR BENEVOLENT PURPOSE;

(II) PROVIDES FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL DEATH BENEFITS NOT EXCEEDING \$400 PER YEAR AND DISABILITY BENEFITS NOT EXCEEDING \$350 PER YEAR;

(III) DOES NOT ISSUE BENEFIT CERTIFICATES;
AND

(IV) DOES NOT HAVE A MEMBERSHIP OF MORE THAN 1,000 INDIVIDUALS.

(B) COMPENSATION FOR OBTAINING NEW MEMBERS PROHIBITED.

EXCEPT [[A SOCIETY]] FOR AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) (2) AND (3) OF THIS SECTION, A SOCIETY WHICH IS EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT GIVE, ALLOW, OR PROMISE TO GIVE OR ALLOW TO ANY PERSON ANY COMPENSATION FOR OBTAINING NEW MEMBERS.

(C) APPLICATION TO ACCIDENT BENEFIT SOCIETIES.

EVERY SOCIETY WHICH PROVIDES BENEFITS IN CASE OF DEATH OR DISABILITY THAT RESULT, SOLELY FROM ACCIDENTS
