subsection (b) of this section. The first two sentences of the last paragraph of §90(f) are incorporated in §7-204 of this article. The last sentence of that paragraph, which provides that qualification to do intrastate business also constitutes registration to do intrastate and foreign business, is deleted as unnecessary in light of §7-202(a).

Provisions relating to the certification of a mailing address and a resident agent are contained in §7-205 of this subtitle.

Provisions relating to the termination of qualification by a foreign corporation are contained in $\S7-208$ of this subtitle.

Provisions relating to the forfeiture of the right to do intrastate business for failure to file required reports are contained in § 7-304 of this title. See, also, §1-405 of this article relating to injunctions against doing business in the case of a corporate or noncorporate business which is involved with "organized crime."

The term "foreign corporation" is defined in Title 1 of this article.

7-204. CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR QUALIFICATION.

A CORPORATION WHICH IS REGISTERED OR QUALIFIED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR QUALIFICATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT. THE CERTIFICATE SHALL SHOW THE ADDRESS OF ANY PRINCIPAL OFFICE IN THIS STATE WHICH IS CERTIFIED TO THE DEPARTMENT.
