pesticides may be sold, distributed, exchanged, or applied only when special permission first is obtained from the Secretary:

- (4) Define the formulations and establish the conditions and appropriate areas for [aircraft] application of any pesticide;
- (5) Establish guidelines and requirements for the application of pesticides [by a public agency or body politic, including the qualifications of the responsible employees] and providing for submission of records to the Secretary:
- (6) Design and conduct an appropriate educational program on the [values] USE of pesticides and the necessity for care when applying them;
- (7) Encourage <u>, CONDUCT</u> AND SUPPORT research which will contribute to optimal uses of pesticides for maximum public benefit and minimum public damage;
- (8) [Establish record systems for pesticide use when essential for the public welfare; and] REQUIRE THAT RECORDS BE KEPT BY ALL LICENSEES AND OTHER USERS OF PESTICIDES;
- (9) Employ inspectors and other employees necessary for the proper enforcement of the provisions of this subtitle and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to it[.];
- (10) COORDINATE AND SUFPORT PESTICIDE MONITORING PROGRAMS; AND
- (11) ESTABLISH APPROPRIATE CATEGORIES AND, IF NECESSARY, SUBCATEGORIES OF APPLICATORS OF PESTICIDES.

The Secretary may inspect any device, [apparatus, or ground equipment, used for custom application of pesticides by aircraft and may require proper repairs or other changes before the device, apparatus, or ground equipment is used for custom application by aircraft.] CONTAINER, PRODUCT, APPARATUS OR EQUIPMENT USED OR INTENDED FOR USE IN PEST CONTROL OPERATIONS, ANY ESTABLISHMENT FROM WHICH PEST CONTROL IS CONDUCTED, AND ANY PESTICIDE APPLICATION OR TREATMENT PERFORMED BY A CERTIFIED APPLICATOR OR SOMEONE UNDER HIS SUPERVISION.
