UNDER A STATE PLAN APPROVED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY. REGISTRATION SHALL EXPIRE AT THE END OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR, AND MAY BE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED ON THE SAME GROUNDS AS OTHER CERTIFICATION PURSUANT TO THIS ACT, OR UPON SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION BY THE APPLICATORS' STATE OF RESIDENCE, []

THE SECRETARY MAY ENTER INTO RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES TO PROVIDE THAT NON-RESIDENT APPLICATORS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF CERTIFIED UNDER EQUIVALENT PLANS OF OTHER STATES APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY GRANTING SIMILAR EXEMPTIONS TO RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE, UPON PAYMENT OF SUCH FEES AS ARE REQUIRED BY MARYLAND APPLICATORS AND UPON MEETING ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE AGREEMENT.

[[SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all certificates issued to pest control operators without examination pursuant to Chapter 438 of the Acts of 1972 shall be null and void as of October 21, 1976, or such other date as is prescribed by federal law or the Environmental Protection Agency, unless prior to that date such operators shall pass the examination as required by this Act.]]

PERMITS ISSUED BY THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE PESTICIDE APPLICATOR'S LAW, PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1975 ARE VALID UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY FEDERAL LAW OR REGULATION.

SECTION [[5]] 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
